PEOPLE WHO HELP US- GRADE III



On 15.07.2025 std III children did People who helps us activity , students were dressed up like Doctor, Farmer, Electrician, Plumber, Vegetable seller, Post man, teacher , and they spoke few words about their profession .For Standard III children, "People Who Help Us" activities can focus on introducing community helpers and their roles. The goal is to help children understand who provides various services and how these helpers contribute to their safety, well-being, and overall community.

PLACE VALUE OF NUMBERS ACTIVITY GRADE III



Place value can be defined as the value represented by a digit in a number on the basis of its position in the number. In order to promote Problem-solving skills in real-life scenarios this activity is conducted for Std III children on 14.07.2025. It provides the foundation for regrouping, multiple-digit multiplication, and more in the decimal system, as well as a starting point for the understanding of other base systems.

TAMIL SPROUT ACTIVITY- GRADE IV



Mulaipari is a traditional Tamil Nadu activity where students sprout nine different types of grains (Navadhanyam) in a pot of soil, symbolizing growth and prosperity. On 15.07.2025 this activity is conducted for std IV students, it's a hands-on way to connect with cultural heritage and learn about agriculture and nature. The activity culminates in a celebration, often involving a dance and taking the sprouted plants to a temple.

LIGHT HOUSE-TAMIL ACTIVITY GRADE VII



As part of their Tamil subject activity, the students of Class VII designed and presented lighthouse models (Kalangarai Vilakku). The activity helped students connect literature and culture by exploring the significance of lighthouses as mentioned in Tamil texts, while also encouraging creativity and teamwork. Students used various materials to create attractive models, showcasing both artistic skills and their understanding of the cultural importance of lighthouses in Tamil heritage. 
